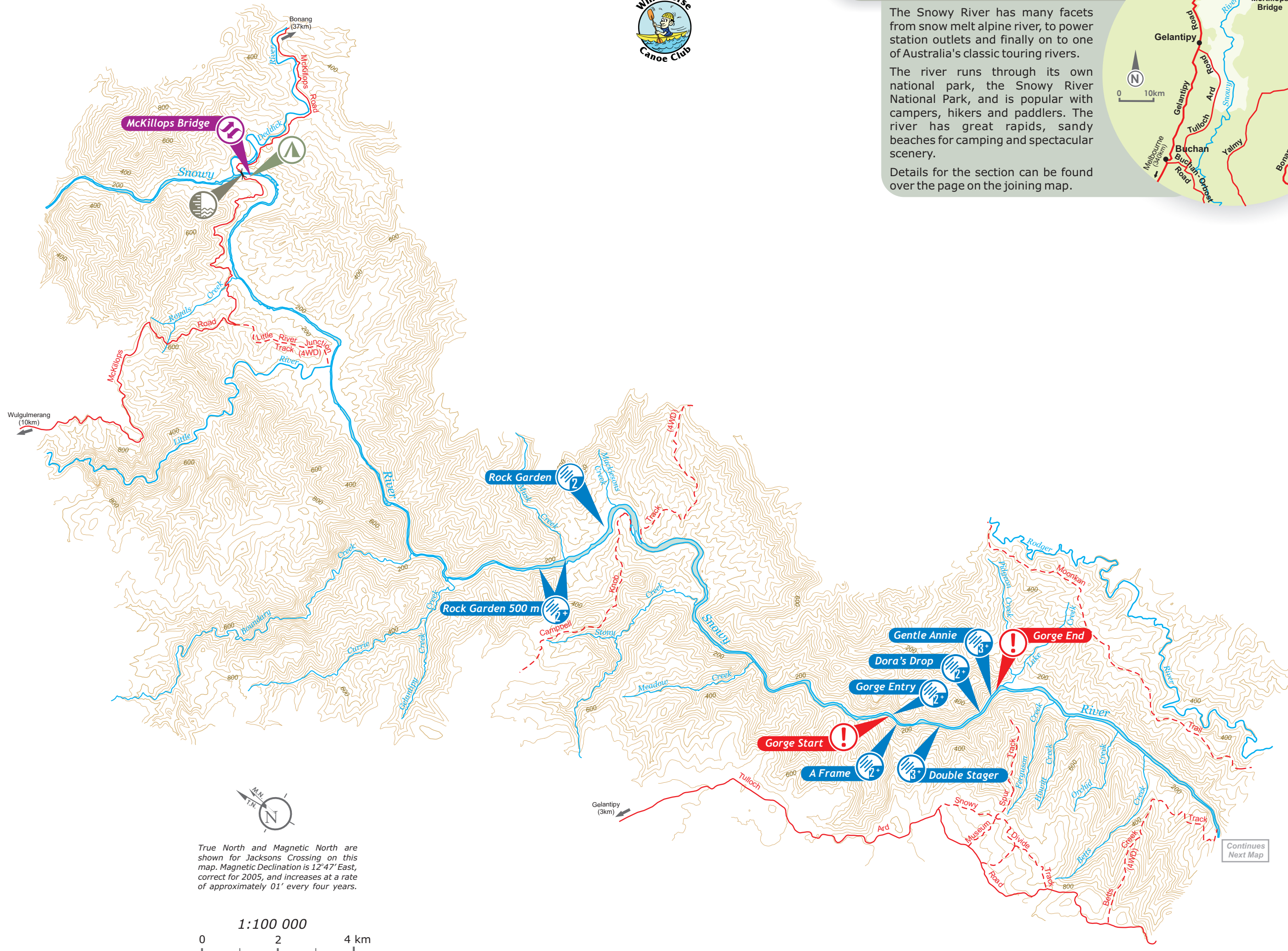


overview

The Snowy River has many facets from snow melt alpine river, to power station outlets and finally on to one of Australia's classic touring rivers.

The river runs through its own national park, the Snowy River National Park, and is popular with campers, hikers and paddlers. The river has great rapids, sandy beaches for camping and spectacular scenery.
