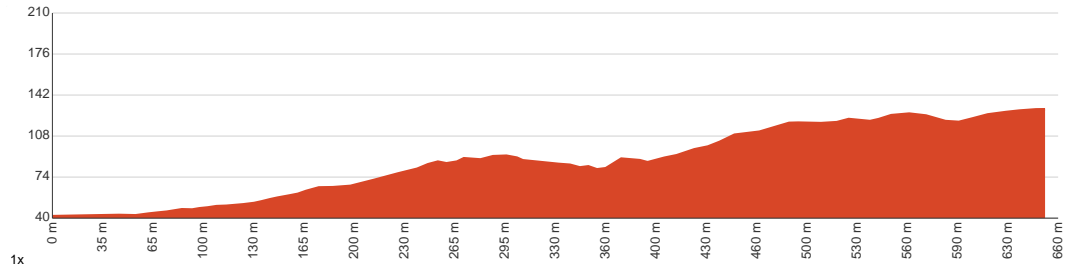

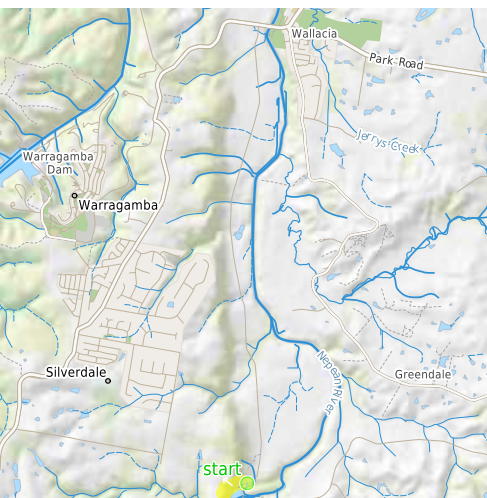

Hard track

Starting from Bents Basin Road car park this return walk takes you through Bents Basin State Conservation Area to the Caleys Lookout. There's a picnic table at the lookout so you can have your lunch there or once back at the start at the Bents Basin Road picnic area. Let us begin by acknowledging the Darug & Tharawal people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.



Class 4 of 6 Rough track, where fallen trees and other obstacles are likely	
Quality of track	Clear and well formed track or trail (2/6)
Gradient	Short steep hills (3/6)
Signage	Minimal directional signs (4/6)
Infrastructure	Limited facilities (such as cliffs not fenced, significant creeks not bridged) (4/6)
Experience Required	No experience required (2/6)
Weather	Forecasted & unexpected storms and severe weather may impact on navigation and safety (4/6)



Getting to the start: From Silverdale Road

- Turn on to Bents Basin Road then drive for 7.4 km

Before you start any journey ensure you;

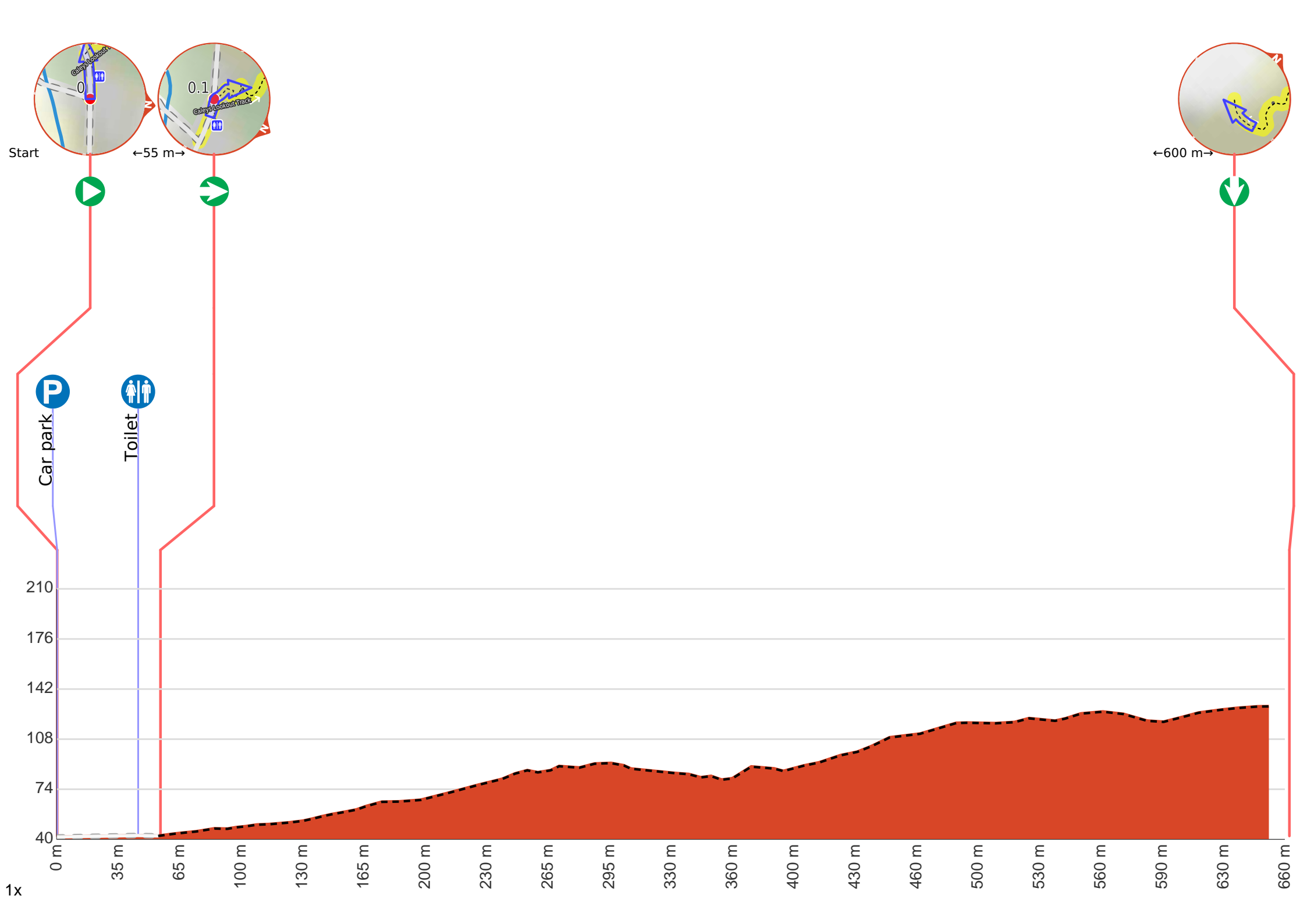
- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

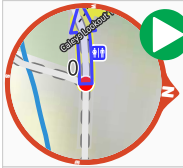
If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.

Find the car park at the start.



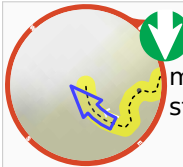
After 45 m pass the toilet (15 m on your right).



After another 10 m **turn right**.



After another 600 m come to "Caleys Lookout".



Turn around here and retrace the main route for 650 m to get back to the start.
