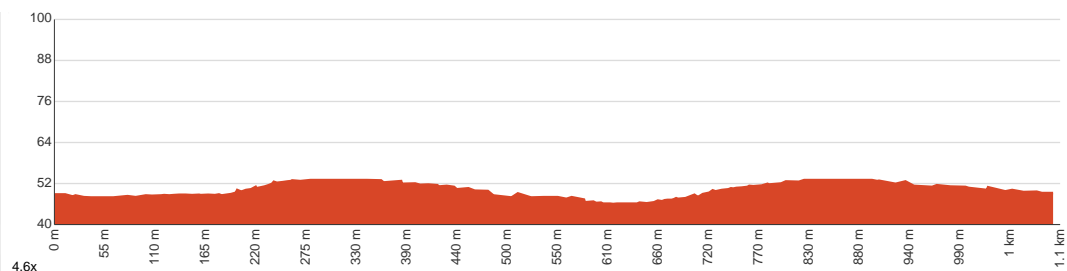
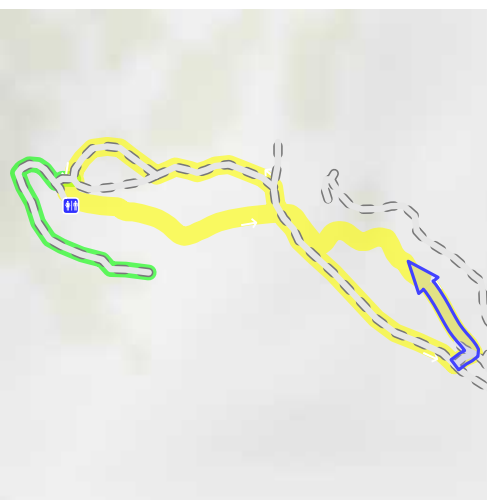

Easy track

Starting from the Cockleshell Gully Road picnic area, Warradarge, this walk takes you on a stroll, visiting the Stockyard Gully Cave along the way. The trail reaches a refreshing limestone cave after it traverses along a sandy gully. The roof of the cave is high enough for visitors to stand and walk. It is an exhilarating experience and suitable for those who have never visited a cave before, thanks to its high ceiling. The caves are historically important as Stockmen used gullies as a natural pen for their cattle in the past. Remember to take a torch with you and be cautious not to hurt bats on the ceiling. Insect repellents are advised, and there are beehives close to the entrances of the cave. There are only short steep sections. Let us begin by acknowledging the Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.

Gradient	Gentle hills with occasional steps (2/6)
Signage	Clearly signposted (1/6)
Infrastructure	Generally useful facilities (such as fenced cliffs and seats) (2/6)
Experience Required	No experience required (1/6)
Weather	Weather generally has little impact on safety (1/6)

Getting to the start: From Indian Ocean Drive, 60, Green Head.

- Turn on to Coorow-Green Head Road then drive for 14.7 km
- Turn sharp left onto Cockleshell Gully Road and drive for another 9.3 km
- Continue onto Gould Simpson Road and drive for another 5.4 km
- Turn right and drive for another 1 m

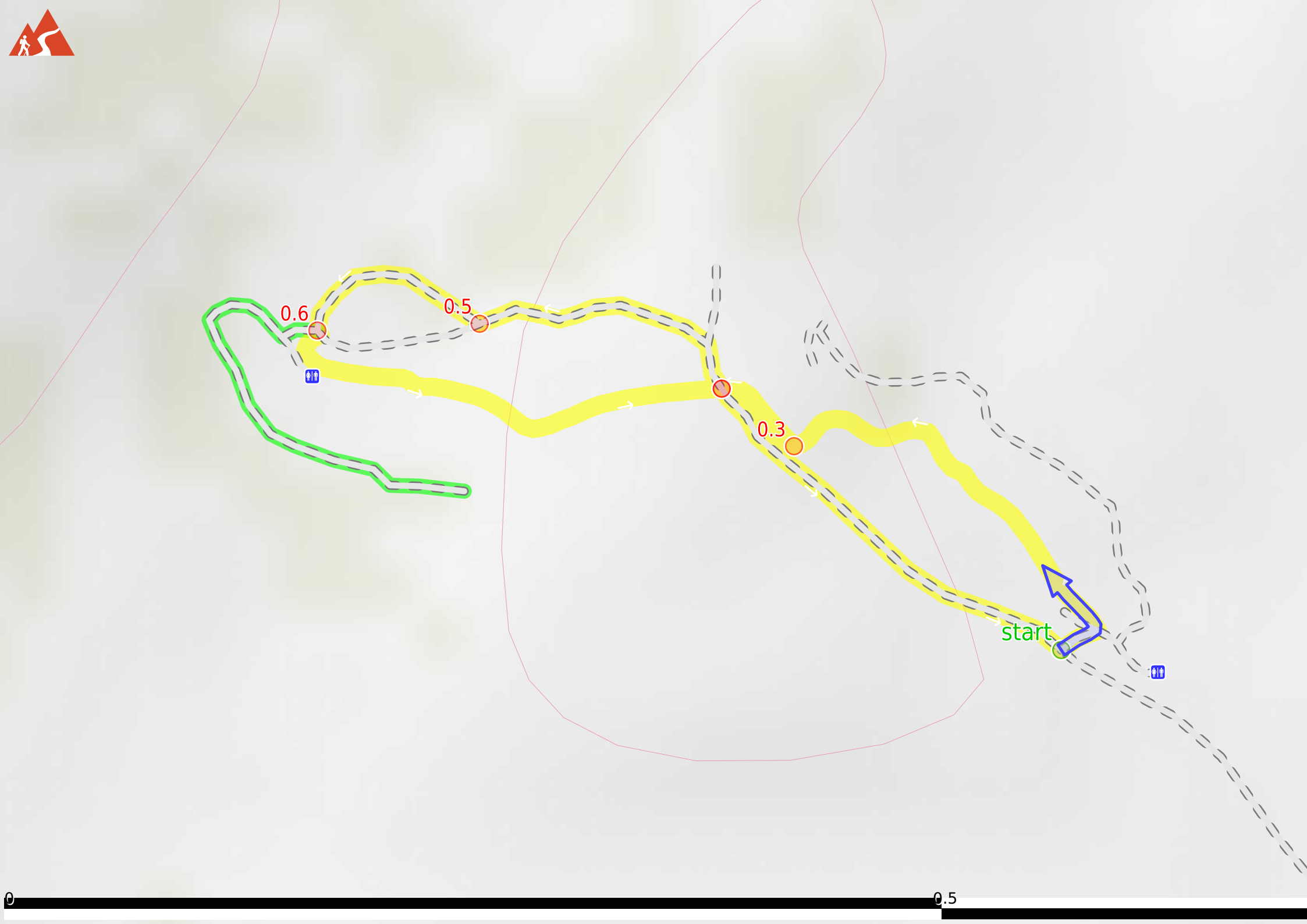
Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.

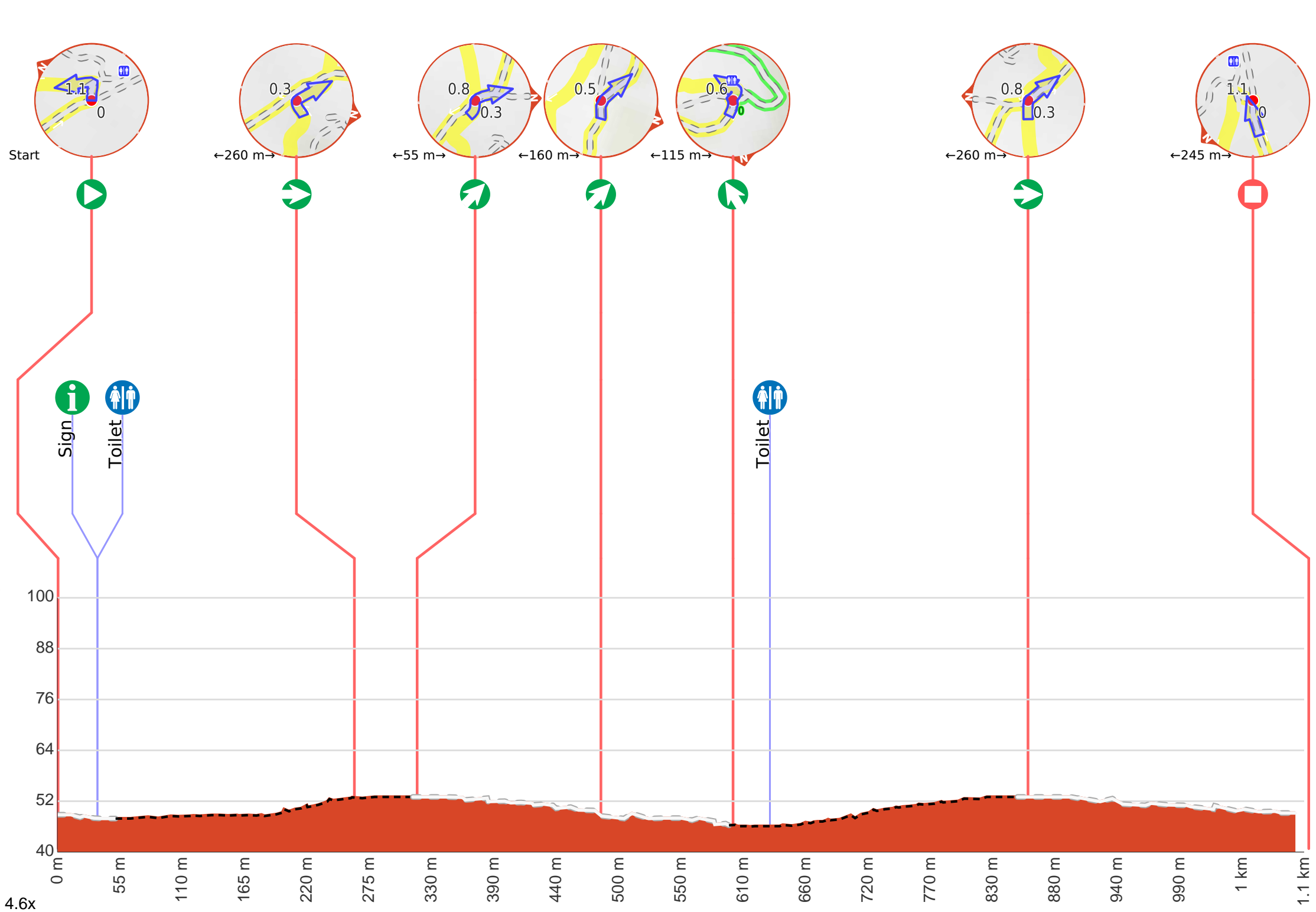

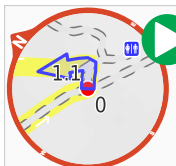

Start.



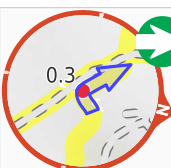
After 35 m pass the sign (about 9 m ahead).



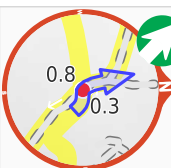
Then pass the toilet (40 m on your right).



Turn left.



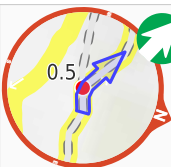
After another 235 m **turn right.**



After another 55 m **veer right.**

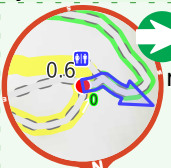


After another 30 m **veer left.**



After another 130 m **veer right.**

Start of an optional side trip: This side trip takes you to the aforementioned limestone cave.



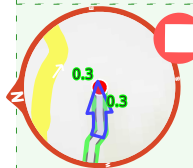
To start this optional side trip turn right here. **Start.**



Find the sign at the start.



Turn right.



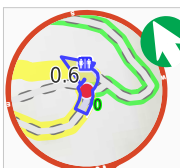
After another 240 m come to the end.



Turn around and retrace your steps back the 260 m to the main route.



Back at the main route turn sharp left and follow on from the 590 m waypoint.



After another 115 m **veer left.**



After another 3 m **turn right.**



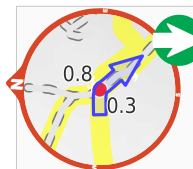
After another 15 m **turn left.**



After another 15 m pass the toilet (7 m on your right).



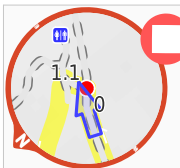
After another 15 m **continue straight.**



After another 215 m **turn right.**



After another 45 m **continue straight.**



After another 200 m come to the end.
