

## Lyrebird Walking Track (Dunghutti Country)










As the name suggests, this circuit walk in New England National Park might offer you a chance to see some lyrebirds. Either way you will enjoy a great range of of environments and see lots of wildlife. Let us begin by acknowledging the Dunghutti people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.







Class 3 of 6 Formed track, with some branches and other obstacles	
Quality of track	Formed track, with some branches and other obstacles (3/6)
Gradient	Short steep hills (3/6)
Signage	Directional signs along the way (3/6)
Infrastructure	Limited facilities, not all cliffs are fenced (3/6)
Experience Required	Some bushwalking experience recommended (3/6)
Weather	Storms may impact on navigation and safety (3/6)

**Getting to the start**: From Grafton Road, B78, 17, Ebor.

- Turn on to Point Lookout Road then drive for 9.7 km
- Keep left onto Point Lookout Road and drive for another 4.2 km
- Turn right and drive for another 195 m
- Turn right and drive for another 25 m


## Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point · Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.









Start heading along Lyrebird Walk.




There is a toilet (about 50 m back from the




After another 450 m (at the intersection of Lyrebird Walk & Tea Tree Falls Walk) continue straight, to head along Lyrebird Walk.

Start of an optional side trip: Side trip to lookout with views.











The end.





After another 1.1 km veer right, to head along Lyrebird Walk.



After another 40 m come to the viewpoint (6 m on your left).



After another 120 m come to the viewpoint (20 m on your left).

Start of an optional side trip: Side trip to lookout with views.



To start this optional side trip turn left here. Start.



After another 20 m come to a viewpoint.



The end.



Turn around and retrace your steps back the 20 m to the main route.




Back at the main route turn left and follow on from the 1.6 km waypoint.




Continue straight, to head along Lvrebird Walk.



After another 1.3 km continue straight, to head along Lyrebird Walk.







After another 30 m cross the bridge (about 3 m lona)



After another 380 m cross the ford.



After another 60 m cross the ford.




Then head up the 16 surface|wood steps (about 4 m long)



After another 25 m cross the ford.



After another 740 m head up the 12 surface|wood steps (about 2 m long)





After another 620 m come to the "Platypus Valley Lookout" (25 m on your right).

At the intersection of Eagles Nest Track & Lyrebird Walk continue straight, to head along Eagles Nest Track.





After another 210 m turn left.
